



US LACROSSE FACILITY POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR SPECTATORS, GUESTS & PARTICIPANTS

SAFETY: Only authorized personnel may operate facility systems (i.e. lights, scoreboard, public address). Guests and fans must stay off the field. Please report any suspicious or inappropriate behavior to US Lacrosse staff. In case of inclement weather, please strictly follow field and stadium evacuation policies. In case of an emergency, please call 911.

BAG POLICY: bags subject to search. Bags are to remain with the guest or visitor at all times.

PROHIBITED ITEMS: Illegal drugs, weapons, animals (except guide or service dogs), bicycles, skates, or skateboards, coolers, air horns, glass containers, lacrosse sticks, balls. Umbrellas are not permitted in the stadium seating area.

PERMITTED ITEMS: Food and non-alcoholic beverages are allowed only with prior approval and only in designated areas. Blankets, tarps, coats/jackets, binoculars, seat cushions, necessary medical equipment, iPads, tablets.

ALCOHOL: alcohol is not to be served or consumed by staff or guests anywhere on campus unless as part of a formal US Lacrosse catered event.

SMOKING POLICY: The US Lacrosse campus is completely smoke/tobacco product/e-cigarette free.

BEHAVIOR: Foul and abusive language will not be tolerated. Profanity on printed clothing is not tolerated. Appropriate attire and footwear must be worn at all times. Only personal audio devices with headsets are allowed. Trash must be placed in trash receptacles.

EJECTION: US Lacrosse reserves the right to remove, or have removed, any person(s) due to abusive conduct or a non-cooperative attitude.



ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) Seating and Parking: accessible seating is available on our promenade facing the field. ADA parking is available in our south parking lot.

PARKING: US Lacrosse has 214 parking spaces; 8 are ADA and 5 are reserved for MedStar patients during their business hours. Vehicles must park in the spaces and not along curbs. Vehicles may never block driveways, entrances or other vehicles. For some events, overflow parking will be available on Loveton Circle as well as the Firaxis Games lot to the immediate west.

TAILGATING: is allowed but alcohol is not allowed anywhere on the US Lacrosse campus, except as part of a US Lacrosse sanctioned event. Trash should always be placed in receptacles. Open flame or charcoal cooking is not allowed on the US Lacrosse campus or on any surrounding streets or parking lots.

VIDEO EQUIPMENT: use of video equipment is prohibited unless otherwise authorized by US Lacrosse.

RE-ENTRY: this is allowed with ticket and wristband. Bags and other items may be searched.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE: should this be required, please see a US Lacrosse staff member who will contact the appropriate individual or service.

LOST AND FOUND: belongings left at an event will be collected and stored at the main first floor lobby desk. Please call 410-235-6882 # ext 100 for more information.

NEIGHBORS: US Lacrosse reminds everyone to be respectful of our residential and corporate neighbors at all times.

RETAIL SALES: No person shall engage in any sale of merchandise, services or operate any concessions without prior approval.



FIELD USE: GreenFields MX usage restrictions: No metal spiked shoes, no food, no liquids (except water), no glass, no chewing gum, no tobacco products, no flame instruments, no animals and no vehicles (except Gators or golf carts or EMS) at any time. The appropriate shoes must be worn at all times; no flip flops. Water is the only beverage that may be on the field.
